Program

The purpose of this program is to learn how to meet the challenges of maintaining a successful Diabetes Self-Management Education and Support (DSMES) program. Completion of this accredited diabetes education certificate program meets one of the requirements for a facility applying to become a recognized DSMES program which qualifies the facility to bill Medicare for outpatient Diabetes Self-Management Training (DSMT).

- The program is an online, self-study, self-paced program. Pharmacists will have 3 months from the date of program registration to complete all coursework and required activities.
- Upon proof of successful completion of all requirements, pharmacists will receive 15.5 hours of ACPE continuing pharmacy education credits and a certificate of program completion.
