Program

The purpose of this program is to prepare pharmacists to improve medication use through the delivery of MTM services in a variety of practice settings. It includes an overview of the marketplace for delivering MTM services, guidance for implementing MTM services in pharmacy practice, a review of the essential skills and knowledge needed for performing MTM successfully, and an organized process for identifying medication-related problems.

- The program includes 10 hours of self-study, an 8 hour live seminar, and a 3 hour post-seminar case exercise. Plan to attend one of the live seminars held on April 29, 2020 or May 13, 2020 at Creighton University in Omaha from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm.
- Upon successful completion of all requirements, pharmacists will receive 21.0 contact hours of ACPE continuing pharmacy education credits and a certificate of achievement.
